St Angela's College School Shoes

St Angela's College is very proud of its students and the school uniform which clearly identifies and distinguishes them. We expect our students to wear the uniform with dignity and with pride and to be aware that, when in uniform, they represent not just themselves but the whole school community. Our school uniform is a huge part of our identity at St Angela's College as a community of learners. We ask that <u>all</u> our students wear the correct uniform to school each day and whenever they represent the school at events outside of school. We remind all of our students, in all year groups that no deviations are permitted, such as non-uniform jacket-wear, headwear or footwear. It is important that our pupils learn the life-skills of good grooming and take pride in their uniform and appearance.

The school uniform will be inspected at regular intervals by the Learning Monitor, Class teachers, Subject teachers and School Management. The uniform policy will be implemented in the context of the **Code of Behaviour**. We thank our parents, guardians and students for their support. More often than not most uniform infringements occur with footwear, the following is an extract from our uniform policy, **"Black or navy, low-heeled shoes (maximum heel height: 3 cms) No** *branded or brand logos or sportswear trainers/runners/pumps/shoes/boots such as Vans, Converse, Uggs etc. (a plain black leather effect Converse/vans shoes are acceptable)*". We are not asking parents to purchase a specific brand, a **non-branded** similar shoe is perfectly acceptable. The following should give some guidance on what shoe wear will be acceptable.
